Year Groups:

Our 6th years have been very actively engaged with the Guidance department for the past few weeks making choices for 3rd level and future career options. Reminder that **Monday 1st February at 5.15pm** is the deadline for those students applying to CAO. Currently, mock examinations for 6th Year students have been rescheduled for a minimum notice date of 2 weeks after we return to in-school classes. All of this planning is hugely subject to DES/SEC dates and other variables. The Leaving Certificate year mock exams are a very important process that will help students complete their focused coursework and get as much important feedback as possible to improve until June. They are also essential in helping to prepare for the length and experience of the state exams. The mocks timetable that we create, tries as much as possible to replicate the Leaving Certificate experience. As it stands we are still working toward the Leaving Certificate in June because we have not been given any instruction otherwise.
